

Make a Lap Robe Quilt for your 2012 zone Banner

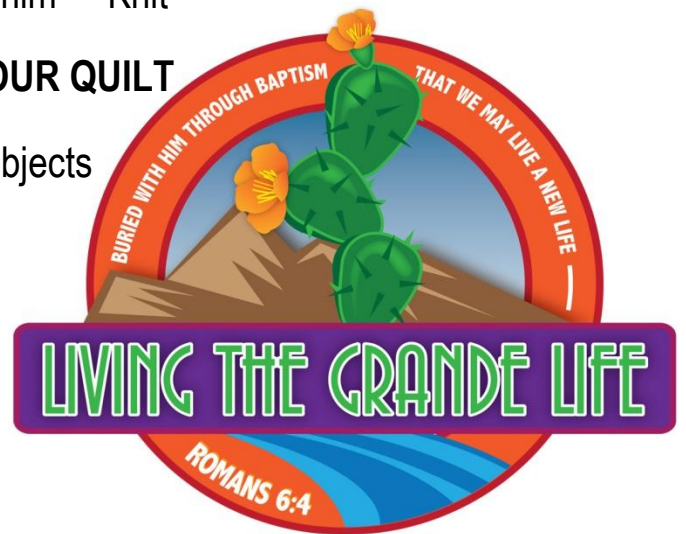
The RMD Executive Committee, after the success at the 2010 Convention in Grand Junction, once again is asking each zone to make a quilt to be used as the zone banner and then will be given to individuals in the hosting zones.

Suggested Size: 36" by 40" (lap robe size)

Fabric Suggestions: -Cotton - Fleece -Soft Denim - Knit

PLEASE DO NOT ADD THE FOLLOWING TO YOUR QUILT

- -Beads, Buttons, Bows, Ribbons, Hanging Objects
- -Anything that could separate from the quilt
- -A casing for a dowel rod
- -Hanging hooks
- -Large letters identifying your zone name



Details:

- The quilt will be carried in the opening procession by the president, young woman representatives, and teen representative from each zone. (Two of the zone representatives can hold a top corner of the quilt.)
- Zone names will be printed on a sign and handed out during processional practice and carried in by one of the zone representatives.
- No banner poles or stands will be used for display.
- Quilts will be displayed in the main session room throughout the convention. (Quilts will be hung up or laid out for display.)
- Zones are welcome and encouraged to make more than one quilt; however only one quilt will be used in the opening procession.
- Quilt designs may be based on the convention logo, but is not required. Any theme, design, or color is acceptable.
- Talk to your zone president to submit an idea for your banner design. Let's share our Love for Jesus with the elderly and needy in the Pecos and Rio Grande zones!
